ICT Business Committee submits report

Members of the Team which comprised of staff drawn from the ICT and the faculty of computing explained that they were able to identify all contentious areas and weaknesses of the existing module and made tremendous progress in resolving them. After rating the progress of the project to as high as 75%, they assured the Director of speedy completion of the project.

In his final remark, the Director said that plans are on the way to invite all Heads of Departments as well as examination officers to an interactive session in January, 2021, to scrutinize and subject the module to integrity test before the final approval by the Vice-Chancellor.
